Corn gluten can increase the milk yield

Tests at KFC show that dairy cows repay with up to 5,9 kg ekstra milk daily, if administered more AAT in the form of corn gluten 60 in the first weeks after calving.

In the tests at KFC the cows were administred more AAT in the form of protein sources corn gluten 60, Soy Pass og Protamyl. These feed stuffs were added to the basic ration in order to increase the AAT-level from 10 g per MJ to 21 g per MJ.



Even though corn gluten is a relatively expensive feed stuff, the yield increase was sizable enough to cover the expenses for the extra protein.

Corn gluten will be available in R2 Agro-Feed Solutions' product range from April 2014.
